Where is Seminarfest held?

Where is the best place to stay?

Rio All-Suites Hotel & Casino, ASSP's official hotel for Seminarfest, has special prices for event attendees. The rates are: Friday and Saturday \$165; Sunday-Thursday \$105 plus a \$20 daily resort fee and tax. The hotel reservation deadline is **January 1, 2019**. Please make your hotel reservations early as the hotel rooms at ASSP's rate may sell out before the deadline. After the cut-off date, the hotel has the option to charge a higher rate if rooms are available.

How long is each course?

Full Day Course hours: 8:00 AM – 4:30 PM with lunch from 12:00 – 1:30pm
Half Day Course hours: 8 AM – 12 PM (AM session) and 12:30 – 4:30 PM (PM session)
Registration desk hours: 7:00 AM – 4:30 PM

What is included in my registration?

All Course materials (as applicable) along with access to electronic materials. CEUs will be awarded via your transcript through the ASSP Academy. There will be morning and afternoon coffee breaks. **NOTE: You must present photo identification at registration.**

What is NOT included in my registration?

Breakfast, dinner, travel, hotel, and parking accommodations are the responsibility of the attendee and are not included in the cost of registration.

Is lunch provided?

Lunch is provided for all Full Day courses.

What should I bring?

All course materials will be provided. Please bring a writing instrument and a calculator if your course requires. We recommend bringing a jacket or something to keep warm as the rooms are kept cold.

Can I get a group discount?

How do I get my Continuing Education Units (CEUs)?

To receive CEUs attendees need to be present for the education hours of the sessions and participate in the learning activities provided. CEUs will be posted to your ASSP transcript in approximately 30 days after the last day of the conference.

1/2day course = 0.4 CEUs

1-day course = 0.7 CEUs

2-day course = 1.4 CEUs

3-day course = 2.1 CEUs

What if I need to cancel?

Full refunds will be granted to written requests received by **January 2, 2019** via email to CustomerService@assp.org or fax to +1.847.768.3434. No shows or cancellations received on or after **January 3, 2019** will not receive a refund.

If, for any reason, ASSP must cancel a course or event, liability is limited solely to the registration fees paid. Can I make a substitution?

If pricing for the new attendee changes the total cost of attending the event, you will be charged or refunded for the difference in fees.

Is there bus service if the hotel sells out?

Currently, we do not provide bus service to the venue, however you can work with the hotel you are staying at to arrange transportation.

Can I leave early from class?

Yes, however attendees must attend the full training day to receive the corresponding CEUs.

Do I need to get a badge?

Yes, badges should be picked up at the registration desk which is open from 7am to 4pm. All attendees are required to wear their badge throughout the event. Your badge allows you access to those courses included in your registration fee.
